Re: Kaman Policy for Gifts, Gratuities, Meals and Entertainment

Positive professional relationships with customers and suppliers are important to the success of our business. Occasionally, friendships may even be formed as a result of such interactions. As such, it is only natural during the holiday season to desire to express feelings of gratitude in the form of gifts, entertainment, meals or other gratuities, whether by giving or receiving such items. However, it is essential to recognize the importance of maintaining appropriate armslength relationships with those whom we do business, including all current or potential customers, suppliers, distributors, agents and vendors who provide or seek to provide goods and services to our company. Kaman's policy regarding the giving and receipt of gifts, gratuities, entertainment and meals ("Gifts") is described more fully in the Kaman Code of Business Conduct and Ethics (the "Code"), accessible at Corporate Governance | Kaman Corporation.

The Code and the policies set forth therein apply to every employee, officer and director of Kaman Corporation and each of its subsidiaries and affiliates, irrespective of geographic location. Supplemental policies or guidelines may be established by a subsidiary or affiliate, so long as such business unit policy is no less restrictive than the Code. Additionally, no business unit policy may conflict with, restrict or otherwise create ambiguities with respect to the Code. Please contact the Corporate Legal and Compliance Department if you require clarification or additional information in this regard.

As the holiday season approaches, please ensure that employees are aware of, understand and comply with their obligations under the Code and Company's policies for giving and receiving Gifts. Stress the importance of appearances that may be associated with such actions. All Gift-related activities must be based on sound business judgment and must be appropriate so as to maintain ethical and arms-length relationships with third parties. It is never appropriate to offer, give or accept funds or property to or from a government official or any other person or entity to induce or influence an action for the Company's benefit. Appropriate measures must be taken to avoid the appearance of impropriety, even when an activity is not intended to induce or influence a third party's actions.

Please distribute this memorandum to employees within your organization, particularly those who may interact with customers, participate in the acquisition of goods and services, or those likely to receive Gifts from third parties.

In accordance with our annual practice, attached is a suggested format for a letter that may be sent to suppliers and vendors to remind them of the Company's policy and expectations. Please feel free to modify the letter as you feel appropriate for your operations.

## [SAMPLE FORM OF LETTER TO CUSTOMERS, SUPPLIERS, DISTRIBUTORS, AGENTS & VENDORS]

#### Ladies and Gentlemen:

We extend greetings for the holiday season and our sincere appreciation to everyone in your organization who has helped us meet our commitments this year. At this time of year, we also want to call your attention to our company policy regarding the solicitation, giving and receipt of gifts, gratuities, meals and entertainment (referred to collectively herein as "Gifts").

While we discourage offers of such Gifts whenever possible, acceptance of any Gift by a Kaman employee is limited to token items of nominal value which do not contravene any applicable law or company policy. Kaman's policy regarding giving or receipt of Gifts is set forth in the Kaman Code of Business Conduct and Ethics, which may be accessed at <a href="Corporate Governance">Corporate Governance</a> | <a href="Kaman Corporation">Kaman Corporation</a>.

Under our policy, Kaman employees may not give or accept Gifts in order to influence a business decision, or if doing so would create the appearance of a conflict of interest. Extravagant, inappropriate or frequent gifts, gratuities, meals or entertainment are prohibited even if they are acceptable by local custom. Offers to our employees of cash or cash equivalents (e.g., gift certificates, gift cards, etc.) are always prohibited under our policy.

We value our relationship with your organization and appreciate your cooperation with adhering to our policy so that we may maintain our arms-length impartiality and compliance requirements. Your assistance in making our company policy known to your employees would be greatly appreciated.
